Recommended Host Communities to Consider

(Relatively) Larger Cities:

- Campobasso: The regional capital—<u>English</u>; <u>Italian</u>
- Termoli: The city by the sea—<u>English; Italian</u>
- Venafro: The gateway to Molise—English; Italian
- Agnone: The heart of upper Molise—<u>English</u>; <u>Italian</u>

Smaller Villages in the province of Campobasso:

- Colletorto: With a view of lake, farm, and sea—Italian
- Guardiaregia: On the side of the Matese mountains—<u>Italian</u>
- Oratino: A hilltop town near Campobasso—English; Italian
- Provvidenti: A small town with a big heart—<u>Italian</u>
- Roccavivara: A hilltop town above a beautiful sanctuary—<u>English</u>; <u>Italian</u>

Smaller Villages in the province of Isernia:

- Bagnoli del Trigno: Known as the pearl of Italy—<u>English; Italian</u>
- Carpinone: Home of a castle and waterfalls—Italian
- Castel San Vincenzo: Between mountains and lake—<u>English</u>; <u>Italian</u>
- Frosolone: Mountain town with a knife-making tradition—English; Italian
- Scapoli: Beautiful hilltop town with bagpipe and ravioli traditions—English; Italian
